Armor Piece #3: GOSPEL OF PEACE BOOTS!

CALIGAE ~ ROMAN FOOTWEAR

These were heavy-soled hobnailed military sandal-boots.

Paul says our feet should be "fitted with the readiness" that comes from the Gospel of Peace.

HETOIMASIA ~ Greek

Refers to preparation, readiness, ensuring a good foundation, or firm footing.

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." ~ Matthew 28:19-20

As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins, in which you used to live when you followed the ways of this world and of the ruler of the kingdom of the air, the spirit who is now at work in those who are disobedient. ~ Ephesians 2:1-2

And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing. The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel that displays the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

FOUR KEYS OF THE GOSPEL

- 1) God loves you and He has a wonderful plan for your life.
- 2) People are enslaved to sin, held captive by it, and separated from our Holy God. On our own, we cannot know and experience God's love and plan for our lives.
- 3) So God sent Jesus to those who were enslaved, to die for our sins, to set us free from the law of sin and death.
- 4) By accepting this truth about Jesus and making Him the Lord and Savior of our lives, we are set free from sin and begin to know and experience God's love and plan for our lives.

If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. ~ Romans 12:18

Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification. ~ Romans 14:19

Armor Piece #4: SHIELD OF FAITH

In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. ~ Ephesians 6:16

The Roman soldiers actually used two different types of shields. The first was a small, round shield called an **apsis**. It was strapped on the forearm of a soldier and was used to parry blows in hand-to-hand combat.

THUREON ~ GREEK

From the word Thura - meaning door. Refering to a door-sized shield the Romans called the Scutum.

After this, the word of the Lord came to Abram in a vision: "Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your SHIELD, your very great reward." ~ Genesis 15:1

In a desert land He found him, in a barren and howling waste. He SHIELDED him and cared for him; He guarded him as the apple of His eye... ~ Deuteronomy 32:10

About Benjamin he said: "Let the beloved of the Lord rest secure in Him, for He SHIELDS him all day long, and the one the Lord loves rests between His shoulders. ~ Deuteronomy 33:12

Blessed are you, Israel! Who is like you, a people saved by the Lord? He is your SHIELD and helper and your glorious sword. Your enemies will cower before you, and you will tread on their heights. ~ Deuteromony 33:29

Faith is the confidence that God is who He says He is and that He will do everything He has promised to do.
