WHAT GOD HAS GOD SHARES!

TWO BIG WAYS THE OMNIS OF GOD FLOW TO US

1) God's Omnis flow to the faithful

Faith is the confidence that God is who He says He is and that He will do everything He's promised to do.

Where God guides, God provides!

Our commitment always precedes God's provision!

(Now the man Moses was very humble, more so than any man on the face of the earth.) ~ Numbers 12:3

He leads the humble in justice, And He teaches the humble His way. ~ Psalm 25:9

Humble yourselves in the presence of the Lord, and He will exalt you. ~ James 4:10

❖ DIVE IN! ~ Discussion Questions

1. What was one thing Pastor G said this week that spoke directly to you?
2. Are you inspired by that to make a decision, make a change, or take some action in your life?
3. Pastor G reminded us again that "What God has, God shares" and said that God specifically shares with 1) **The Faithful** and 2) **The Humble**. Greg taught that "*Where God guides, God provides*" and also "*Our commitment precedes God's provision.*" Do you agree or disagree with these statements about faith, humility and commitment? Why?

◆ **READ:** *Matthew 17:20, Luke 1:37, Matthew 19:26 and John 14:12-14*

1. Pastor G talks often about the often misunderstood concept of faith. Can you state in your own words how our faith can "move mountains?" What are the Biblical criteria (*especially in the verses you read above*) necessary for a seemingly impossible thing to happen through our faithful prayer?

◆ **READ:** *Proverbs 3:34, Numbers 12:3, Psalm 25:9, and James 4:10*

1. These passages all talk about the value of humility when it comes to the way God interacts with us. How have you found this to be true that God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble? Sometimes in our modern world it seems like prideful people get away with a lot and seem to accumulate for themselves tremendous wealth and influence. Do you think they are getting away with that pride and not suffering any opposition from God? Why or why not?
