So those who accepted his message were baptized, and that day about 3,000 people were added. ~ Acts 2:41

Now in those days, when the disciples were growing in number, a complaint arose on the part of the Greek-speaking Jews against the native Hebraic Jews, because their widows were being overlooked in the daily distribution of food.~ Acts 6:1

So the twelve called the whole group of the disciples together and said, "It is not right for us to neglect the word of God to wait on tables. ~ Acts 6:2

But carefully select from among you, brothers, seven men who are well-attested, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we may put in charge of this necessary task. But we will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word. ~ Acts 6:3-4

The proposal pleased the entire group ... ~ Acts 6:5a

... so they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, with Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolas, a Gentile convert to Judaism from Antioch. 6 They stood these men before the apostles, who prayed and placed their hands on them. ~ Acts 6:5b-6

The word of God continued to spread, the number of disciples in Jerusalem increased greatly, and a large group of priests became obedient to the faith. ~ Acts 6:7

What then is Apollos? And what is Paul? Servants through whom you believed, even as the Lord gave opportunity to each one. I planted, Apollos watered, but God was causing the growth. ~ 1 Corinthians 3:5-6

- 1. What was one thing Pastor G said this week that spoke directly to you?

### ◆ READ: ACTS 2:42-47 and ACTS 6:7

- 1. This was what happened when the entire church got on board with a division of labor and every person serving and helping in some capacity and every person sharing the Good News with their friends, relatives, associates, and neighbors. The Word of God continued to spread, and the number of disciples increased daily. In addition to serving in some way here Greg has also challenged us to each invite at least two people to join us at our church before the end of this year. That would make our average attendance jump from 60 to 180 overnight. Who are the friends, relatives, associates, and neighbors in your circles of influence that you can invite to come sit with you at church this week?
- 2. Greg mentioned that he is going to be teaching some seminars on Developing Spiritual Maturity and on learning how God specifically designed you for meaningful ministry. Are you willing to participate in those two seminars?
