- **1. The Season of Teshuvah** Teshuavah is a Hebrew word for repentance.
- 2. Rosh HaShanah Hebrew for the Head of the Year, the Jewish New Year. Jews celebrate it as the Birthday of the World the day God created the Earth.
- 3. Yom Teruah The Feast of Trumpets or The Day of the Awakening Blast.
- 4. Yom HaDin The Day of Judgment or The Day of The Lord.
- 5. HaMelech The Coronation of the Messiah as the King of Kings.
- 6. Yom HaZikkaron The Day of Remembrance or The Day of Memorial.
- 7. The Time of Jacob's Trouble
- 8. The Opening of the Gates/The Opening of the Books
- **9. Kiddushin** The Wedding Ceremony of the Messiah.
- 10. The Resurrection of the Dead What some refer to as the rapture.
- **11. The Last Trump** The second of three very significant prophetic trumpets blown in Jewish prophecy.
- **12. Yom HaKeseh** The hidden day, also known as the day and the hour that no one knows.
