FALL INTO PLACE ~ Week 5 ~ Sukkot 2 of 3

For seven days you shall present an offering by fire to the Lord. On the eighth day you shall have a holy convocation and present an offering by fire to the Lord; it is an assembly. You shall do no laborious work. ~ Leviticus 23:36

Jesus went to the Mount of Olives. Early in the morning He came again into the temple, and all the people were coming to Him; and He sat down and began to teach them. ~ John 8:1-2

The scribes and the Pharisees brought a woman caught in adultery, and having set her in the center of the court, they said to Him, "Teacher, this woman has been caught in adultery, in the very act. Now in the Law Moses commanded us to stone such women; what then do You say?" ~ John 8:3-5

If there is a man who commits adultery with another man's wife, one who commits adultery with his friend's wife, the adulterer AND the adulteress shall surely be put to death. ~ Leviticus 20:10

They were using this question as a trap, in order to have a basis for accusing Him. But Jesus bent down and started to write on the ground with His finger. ~ John 8:6
