



**YESHUA ~ Week 7**  
**The Resurrection & The Life**

**"Yeshua" became "Iēsoûs" in Greek and then "Iesus" in Latin and eventually "Jesus" in English.**

**SĒMEÍON - GREEK ~ a miraculous sign given to confirm, corroborate or authenticate the end-purpose of and exalt the one giving the sign**

*Martha then said to Jesus, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died." ~ John 11:21*

*"Even now I know that whatever You ask of God, God will give You."  
~ John 11:22*

*Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise again." ~ John 11:23*

*Martha said to Him, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection on the last day." - John 11:24*

*... an hour is coming, in which all who are in the tombs will hear [the Son of God's] voice, and will come forth; those who did the good deeds to a resurrection of life, those who committed the evil deeds to a resurrection of judgment. ~ John 5:28b-29*

*Truly, truly, I say to you, an hour is coming and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live. For just as the Father has life in Himself, even so He gave to the Son also to have life in Himself; and He gave Him authority to execute judgment, because He is the Son of Man. ~ John 5:25-27*

*Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?" ~ John 11:25-26*

*She said to Him, "Yes, Lord; I have believed that You are the Christ, the Son of God, even He who comes into the world." - John 11:27*

*And while they were gathering together in Galilee, Jesus said to them, "The Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men; and they will kill Him, and He will be raised on the third day." And they were deeply grieved.  
~ Matthew 17:22-23*

*But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared. And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. ~ Luke 24:1-3*

*While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men suddenly stood near them in dazzling clothing; ~ Luke 24:4*

### **ASTRAPTÓ - GREEK ~ to flash like lighting**

*and as the women were terrified and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them, "Why do you seek the living One among the dead? He is not here, but He has risen..." ~ Luke 24:5-6a*

*But these words appeared to them as nonsense, and they would not believe them. ~ Luke 24:11*
