

YESHUA ~ WEEK 1 ~ SON OF GOD/SON OF MAN ~ DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1) Before today, did you think that calling Jesus Son of God and Son of Man was only a way to say that He was both God and human? Had you ever made the connection of Jesus' title "Son of Man" with Daniel's vision of the Messiah being "one like a Son of Man" coming in the clouds before today? How does this change your perception when you read this term "Son of Man" in the New Testament?**

- 2) Read Mark 14:60-64 - Have you ever heard an atheist or another critic say something like "Jesus never claimed to be the Son of God?" Given the context of this verse do you think Jesus explicitly claimed to be the Son of God? Why do you think critics of Christianity are so hesitant to admit these were the claims of Jesus Himself and not just the claims of His followers?**

- 3) Read John 1:1-3, John 10:30, and John 14:9 - These are just a few of the places where the Bible states that Jesus is God and that He and the Father are One. This speaks to the doctrine of the Trinity which states; There is one God who eternally exists as three distinct Persons — the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. God is one in essence and three in person. What are some ways that people tend to misunderstand and miscommunicate the Trinity? Have you ever struggled to understand the Trinity?**
