YESHUA ~ WEEK 2 ~ THE WORD/THE WAY ~ DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1) READ PSALM 1:1-6. David indicates that meditating on the Word of God day and night will lead to us to blessing and success. Have you found that to be true in your life as well? Do things seem to "go better" for you when you are more focused on reading and meditating the Word of God?
- 2) READ JOHN 13:17 and JAMES 1:22. Jesus and His brother James tell us there is an additional step beyond reading and meditating on the word of God (or hearing the word of God read.) According to their words, what else is required of us if we really want to experience the blessings of God and the plan and purpose He has in mind for us?
- 3) Reflect on the connection between Jesus as "The Way, The Truth, and The Life" (John 14:6) and the small gate and narrow way He mentions in Matthew 7:13-14. How does this impact our understanding of salvation? How does the concept of Jesus as "The Only Way" in John 14:6 challenge prevailing cultural notions of multiple paths to God being equally viable?
- 4) Discuss the transformative and invincible power of God's Word, as emphasized in Isaiah 55:11, and its relationship to Jesus as the glorious and powerful Word of God, as revealed in John 1:14 and Hebrews 4:12? How has your life been transformed by the Word of God? How has your life been transformed by following THE WAY?
