MOST COMMON MISCONCEPTION IN ANY RELIGIOUS SYSTEM

Salvation/God's approval/eternal life can be earned or merited if we know enough, believe enough, do enough, are good enough.

2014 GALLOP POLL: 43% of Roman Catholics, 20% of Protestants agreed with this statement. "Heaven is a divine reward for those who earn it by their good life."

ACU POLL: 54% of U.S. adults believed they would go to heaven if they lived a good life.

FOUR PROBLEMS WITH THAT VIEWPOINT

- 1) Who sets the standard for what is "good enough?"
- 2) Nobody can ever be "sure" if they are okay with God.
- 3) This view asks God to ignore all of our remaining sins.
- 4) It contradicts what God has already revealed to us in His inspired Word, the Bible.

GOD'S STANDARD FOR "GOOD ENOUGH" is 100% perfection, 100% of the time.

For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles in one point, he has become guilty of all. ~ James 2:10 (NASB 1995)
