

RUACH HA-KODESH Week 7 ~ The Anointing

ALEIPHO - GREEK ~ to rub olive oil on the skin

EGCHRISAIA - GREEK ~ to rub something into the skin or body, but it carries with it the idea that it is specifically for a medicinal purpose

EPICHRIÓ - GREEK ~ to spread a paste on something

She has done what she could; she has anointed My body beforehand for the burial. ~ Mark 14:8 (NASB1995)

MURIZÓ - GREEK ~ a type of anointing with oil, spices and perfumes, specifically connected to burial spices and anointing a dead body

CHRIÓ - GREEK ~ an anointing with olive oil that carries with it the specific purpose of consecrating someone to specific leadership service to God

But it is God who establishes us together with you in Christ and who anointed us ... ~ 2 Corinthians 1:21(NET)

... and from Jesus Christ ... ~ Revelation 1:5a (NET)

has appointed us as a kingdom, as priests serving His God and Father ... ~ Revelation 1:6a (NET)

... you also, as living stones, are being built up as a spiritual house for a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. ~ 1 Peter 2:5 (NASB1995)

But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people of His own, so that you may proclaim the virtues of the One who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light. You once were not a people, but now you are God's people. You were shown no mercy, but now you have received mercy. ~ 1 Peter 2:9-10 (NET)

<u>CHRISMA - GREEK</u> ~ a spiritual anointing rather than a physical anointing

UNCTION - ENGLISH ~ anointed speech

But you have an anointing from the Holy One [you have been set apart, specially gifted and prepared by the Holy Spirit], and all of you know [the truth because He teaches us, illuminates our minds, and guards us from error]. ~ 1 John 2:20 (Amplified)

As for you, the anointing which you received from Him abides in you, and you have no need for anyone to teach you; but as His anointing teaches you about all things, and is true and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you abide in Him. ~ 1 John 2:27 (NASB1995)

I solemnly charge you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom: preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but wanting to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires, and will turn away their ears from the truth and will turn aside to myths. But you, be sober in all things, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry. ~ 2 Timothy 4:1-5 (NASB1995)

But I am afraid that just as the serpent deceived Eve by his treachery, your minds may be led astray from a sincere and pure devotion to Christ. For if someone comes and proclaims another Jesus different from the one we proclaimed, or if you receive a different spirit than the one you received, or a different gospel than the one you accepted, you put up with it well enough! ~ 2 Corinthians 11:3-4 (NET)

TWO THINGS THAT CAUSE PEOPLE TO BE LED ASTRAY

1) NO GROUNDING IN THE WORD OF GOD 2) NO CHRISMA ANOINTING OF THE SPIRIT

Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world. ~ 1 John 4:1 (NASB1995)

Do not quench the Spirit; do not despise prophetic utterances. But examine everything carefully; hold fast to that which is good abstain from every form of evil. - 1 Thessalonians 5:19-22 (NASB 1995)
