SYNTHLIBONTA - GREEK ~ pressing in, crowding, crushing

And He looked around to see the woman who had done this. But the woman fearing and trembling, aware of what had happened to her, came and fell down before Him and told Him the whole truth. ~ Mark 5:32-33 (NASB 1995)

PERIEBLEPETO - GREEK ~ He kept looking around, He was scanning, searching

PHOBETHEISA - GREEK ~ fear

TREMOUSA - GREEK ~ trembling, to quake, to shake visibly

EPESEN - GREEK ~ fell down before Jesus

PASAN TEN ALETHEIAN - GREEK ~ the whole truth

And He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace and be healed of your affliction." ~ Mark 5:34 (NASB 1995)

SOU PISTIS - GREEK ~ your faith

SESOKEN SE - GREEK ~ made you well, or more literally has saved you

❖ MESSAGE NOTES

JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 16

When Jesus had crossed over again in the boat to the other side, a large crowd gathered around Him; and so He stayed by the seashore.

~ Mark 5:21 (NASB 1995)

DIAPERASANTOS PALIN EIS TO PERAN - GREEK ~ crossed over again to the other side

One of the synagogue officials named Jairus came up, and on seeing Him, fell at His feet and implored Him earnestly, saying, "My little daughter is at the point of death; please come and lay Your hands on her, so that she will get well and live." And He went off with him; and a large crowd was following Him and pressing in on Him. ~ Mark 5:22-24 (NASB 1995)

ARCHISYNAGOGOS - GREEK ~ synagogue official, literally, a ruler of the synagogue

PIPTEI PROS TOUS PODAS - GREEK ~ fell at His feet

PARAKALEI AUTON POLLA - GREEK ~ pleaded earnestly with Him

THYGATRION - GREEK ~ little daughter, it is a diminutive form of the word for daughter

ESCHATOS ECHEI - GREEK ~ she has it extremely (a euphemism for death)

APETHNESKEN - GREEK ~ in the process of dying (specified in Luke's Gospel)

SOTHE - GREEK ~ to save, to heal, to deliver

ZESE - GREEK ~ live

A woman who had had a hemorrhage for twelve years, and had endured much at the hands of many physicians, and had spent all that she had and was not helped at all, but rather had grown worse ~ Mark 5:25-26 (NASB 1995)

RHYSIS HAIMATOS - GREEK ~ a flow of blood

after hearing about Jesus, she came up in the crowd behind Him and touched His cloak. For she thought, "If I just touch His garments, **I will get well.**" ~ Mark 5:27-28 (NASB 1995)

Faith comes by **hearing**, and hearing by the word of Christ.
~ Romans 10:17 (NASB 1995)

HEPSATO - GREEK ~ touched, grasped, clung to

The Sun of Righteousness will rise with healing in His wings.
~ Malachi 4:2b (NASB 1995)

Immediately the flow of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of her affliction. ~ Mark 5:29 (NASB 1995)

EXERANTHE - GREEK ~ dried up, withered

PEGE - GREEK ~ flow, spring or fountain

EGNO - GREEK ~ knew, perceived (not just a vague feeling)

IATAI - GREEK ~ had been healed

MASTIGOS - GREEK ~ affliction, literally scourge, whip or plague

Immediately Jesus, perceiving in Himself that the power proceeding from Him had gone forth, turned around in the crowd and said, "Who touched My garments?" ~ Mark 5:30 (NASB 1995)

HO LESOUS EPIGNOUS EN HEAUTO- GREEK ~ Jesus, perceiving in Himself

GNOSKO - GREEK ~ to know

EPIGNOUS - GREEK ~ clear, conscious recognition

DYNAMIS - GREEK ~ power, force, miraculous ability, His divine power

And His disciples said to Him, "You see the crowd pressing in on You, and You say, 'Who touched Me?'" ~ Mark 5:31 (NASB 1995)

BLEPEIS - GREEK ~ You see? (almost sarcastic in tone)
