**JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 20**

*And she went out and said to her mother, "What shall I ask for?" And she said, "The head of John the Baptist." ~ Mark 6:24 (NASB 1995)*

*Immediately she came in a hurry to the king and asked, saying, "I want you to give me at once the head of John the Baptist on a platter." ~ Mark 6:25 (NASB 1995)*

**META SPOUDES - GREEK ~ with haste, with eagerness and zeal**

**EX AUTES - GREEK ~ from this very moment, at once, without delay**

*And although the king was very sorry, yet because of his oaths and because of his dinner guests, he was unwilling to refuse her. ~ Mark 6:26 (NASB 1995)*

**PERILYPOS GENEMENOS - GREEK ~ Having become deeply grieved and distressed, overwhelmed with sorrow**

*Immediately the king sent an executioner and commanded him to bring back his head. And he went and had him beheaded in the prison, and brought his head on a platter, and gave it to the girl; and the girl gave it to her mother. ~ Mark 6:27-28 (NASB 1995)*

*When his disciples heard about this, they came and took away his body and laid it in a tomb. ~ Mark 6:29 (NASB 1995)*

*The apostles gathered together with Jesus; and they reported to Him all that they had done and taught. ~ Mark 6:30 (NASB 1995)*

**APOSTOLOI - GREEK ~ Apostles, sent ones**

*And He said to them, "Come away by yourselves to a secluded place and rest a while." (For there were many people coming and going, and they did not even have time to eat.) They went away in the boat to a secluded place by themselves. ~ Mark 6:31-32 (NASB 1995)*

*The people saw them going, and many recognized them and ran there together on foot from all the cities, and got there ahead of them.*

*~ Mark 6:33 (NASB 1995)*

*When Jesus went ashore, He saw a large crowd, and He felt compassion for them because they were like sheep without a shepherd; and He began to teach them many things. ~ Mark 6:34 (NASB 1995)*

**SPLANCHNIZOMAI - GREEK ~ gut-wrenching, visceral compassion**

*When it was already quite late, His disciples came to Him and said, "This place is desolate and it is already quite late; send them away so that they may go into the surrounding countryside and villages and buy themselves something to eat." ~ Mark 6:35-36 (NASB 1995)*

**EREMOS - GREEK ~ desert, wilderness, isolated place**

*But He answered them, "You give them something to eat!" And they said to Him, "Shall we go and spend two hundred denarii on bread and give them something to eat?" ~ Mark 6:37 (NASB 1995)*

*With man it is impossible, but not with God. For all things are possible with God. ~ Mark 10:27b (NASB 1995)*

*And He said to them, "How many loaves do you have? Go look!" And when they found out, they said, "Five, and two fish." ~ Mark 6:38 (NASB 1995)*
