# JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 25

In those days, when there was <u>again a large crowd</u> and they had nothing to eat, Jesus called His disciples and said to them ~ Mark 8:1 (NASB 1995)

#### PALIN OLU OCHLOS - GREEK ~ again a large crowd

"I feel <u>compassion</u> for the people because they have <u>remained with Me</u> now three days and have nothing to eat. If I send them away hungry to their homes, they will <u>faint</u> on the way; and some of them have come <u>from a great distance</u>." ~ Mark 8:2-3 (NASB 1995)

<u>SPLANCHNIZOMAI - GREEK</u> ~ compassion FROM

**SPLANCHNA - GREEK** ~ literally the bowels, the gut, the inward parts

<u>PROSMENOUSIN - GREEK</u> ~ the sense of clinging, persisting, remaining close with intentionality

**EKLYTHESONTAI - GREEK** ~ to faint, to loosen, to unbind, to grow weary, to collapse

MAKROTHEN - GREEK ~ from far away, from a great distance

And His disciples answered Him, "Where will anyone be able to find enough bread here in this <u>desolate place</u> to satisfy these people?" ~ Mark 8:4 (NASB 1995)

**EREMIA - GREEK** ~ wilderness, desolate place, desert

Faith is the confidence that God is exactly who He says He is and that He will do everything He has promised to do.

And <u>He was asking</u> them, "How many loaves do you have?" And they said, "Seven." ~ Mark 8:5 (NASB 1995) And <u>He directed</u> the people to sit down on the ground; and taking the seven loaves, <u>He gave thanks</u> and broke them, and started giving them to His disciples to serve to them, and they served them to the people.

~ Mark 8:6 (NASB 1995)

#### **PARENGEILIEN - GREEK** ~ He directed

They also had a few <u>small fish</u>; and after He had b<u>lessed them</u>, He ordered these to be served as well. ~ Mark 8:7 (NASB 1995)

<u>ICHTHYDIA - GREEK</u> ~ literally "little fishes"

**EUCHARISTESAS - GREEK** ~ He gave thanks

**EULOGESAS - GREEK ~ He blessed them** 

And they ate and were <u>satisfied</u>; and they picked up seven <u>large baskets</u> full of what was left over of the broken pieces. ~ Mark 8:8 (NASB 1995)

#### **CHORTAZO - GREEK ~ satisfied**

For He has satisfied the thirsty soul, and the hungry soul He has filled with what is good. ~ Psalm 107:9 (NASB 1995)

**KOPHINOS - GREEK** ~ a small hand-basket like a lunch pail (Mark 6)

**SPYRIS - GREEK** ~ a much larger hamper-sized basket (Mark 8)

About four thousand were there; and <u>He sent them away</u>. ~ Mark 8:9 (NASB 1995)

<u>APELUSEN - GREEK</u> ~ He sent them away, He released them, He dismissed them, He let them go.

**EROTA - GREEK** ~ He was asking
