## Sometimes faith and perception come in stages rather than all at once.

And he <u>looked up</u> and said, "<u>I see</u> men, for <u>I see</u> them like trees, walking around." ~ Mark 8:24 (NASB 1995)

<u>ANABLEPSAS/ANABLEPO - GREEK</u> ~ not just "looked up" but could also be translated "regained sight" or "recovered vision."

**BLEPO - GREEK** ~ I see

**HORO - GREEK** ~ I behold/percieve

Then again He laid His hands on his eyes; and <u>he looked intently</u> and <u>was restored</u>, and <u>began to see everything clearly</u>. ~ Mark 8:25 (NASB 1995)

**DIEBLEPEN - GREEK** ~ he looked intently, he fixed his gaze

**APESTATHE - GREEK** ~ he was restored

**ENEBLEPEN TELAUGOS - GREEK** ~ he began to see everything clearly, at a distance

**TELE - GREEK ~ far** 

**AUGE - GREEK** ~ radiance or brightness

**TELAUGOS - GREEK** ~ sharp, far-reaching radiance

Don't fake perfect vision. Bring your blur to Jesus.

And He <u>sent him</u> to his home, saying, "Do not even enter the village." ~ Mark 8:26 (NASB 1995)

#### **APESTEILEN - GREEK** ~ sent him

Sometimes obedience isn't about where Jesus sends you. It's about where He tells you *not* to go.

Sometimes, the most faithful thing you can do is simply not return to the places that blinded you and move forward to a new mission field instead.

## JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 27

Having eyes, do you not <u>see</u>? And having ears, do you not <u>hear</u>? And do you not remember? ~ Mark 8:18 (NASB 1995)

<u>BLEPETE - GREEK</u> ~ physically see, but also spiritual perception, discernment

<u>AKOUETE - GREEK</u> ~ physically hear, but also spiritual receptivity and obedience

<u>MNEMONEUETE - GREEK</u> ~ remember. This isn't about casual recall; it's specificially about keeping God's faithfulness in mind so it shapes how you live today.

...listening, but do not perceive...looking, but do not understand... ~ Isaiah 6:9b (NASB 1995)

...foolish and senseless people, Who have eyes but do not see; Who have ears but do not hear. ~ Jeremiah 5:21b (NASB 1995)

... the rebellious house, who have eyes to see but do not see, ears to hear but do not hear... ~ Ezekiel 12:2b (NASB 1995)

Faith doesn't demand new proof. Faith rightly responds to what we've already seen, heard, and experienced of Him.

"When <u>I broke</u> the five loaves for the five thousand, how many <u>baskets</u> full of broken pieces you picked up?" They said to Him, "Twelve."

~ Mark 8:19 (NASB 1995)

**EKLASA - GREEK** ~ I broke

**KOPHINOUS - GREEK** ~ baskets

"When I broke the seven for the four thousand, how many large <u>baskets</u> full of broken pieces did you pick up?" And they said to Him, "Seven." ~ Mark 8:20 (NASB 1995) <u>SPYRIDAS - GREEK</u> ~ a larger, more flexible Gentile-style basket, big enough to hold a grown man

Faith is remembering not just the miracle, but the meaning of the miracle.

And He was saying to them, "Do you not yet <u>understand?"</u> ~ Mark 8:21 (NASB 1995)

**SYNIEMI - GREEK** ~ to understand, to put together, to synthesize

And they <u>came</u> to <u>Bethsaida</u>. And they <u>brought</u> a blind man to Jesus and <u>implored</u> Him <u>to touch him</u>. ~ Mark 8:22 (NASB 1995)

**BETH - HEBREW** ~ house

**TSAID - HEBREW** ~ fishing

**ERCHONTAI - GREEK** ~ they come (Historical Present)

**PHEROUSIN - GREEK** ~ they bring (Historical Present)

**PARAKALOUSIN - GREEK** ~ they implore (Historical Present)

Sometimes the most faith-filled and grace-filled thing you can do is carry someone else's need into Jesus' presence when they can't navigate there on their own.

HAPSASTHAI AUTOU - GREEK ~ to touch him

<u>Taking</u> the blind man by the hand, <u>He brought him out</u> of the village; and <u>after spitting</u> on his eyes and laying His hands on him, He asked him, "<u>Do you see anything?</u>" ~ Mark 8:23 (NASB 1995)

 $\underline{\text{EPILABOMENOS}}$  -  $\underline{\text{GREEK}}$  ~ taking hold .... This carries the sense of seizing firmly, not a casual brush

**EXENENKEN** - **GREEK** ~ He brought him out. Almost like leading someone out of confinement.

**PTUSAS- GREEK** ~ after spitting

**BLEPEIS TI - GREEK** ~ Are you seeing anything now, anything yet?
