# JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 32

Rejoice always; pray without ceasing; in everything **GIVE THANKS**; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.~ 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 (NASB 1995)

When they came back to the disciples, they saw a large crowd around them, and some scribes <u>arquing</u> with them. ~ Mark 9:14 (NASB 1995)

## **SYZETOUNTAS - GREEK** ~ arguing, debating

Immediately, when the entire crowd saw Him, they were <u>amazed</u> and began running up to <u>greet</u> Him. ~ Mark 9:15 (NASB 1995)

**EKTHAMBEO** - **GREEK** ~ amazed, a sudden emotional shock, astonishment mixed with anxiety

**ASPAZOMAI - GREEK** ~ greet with warmth, welcome and affection

And He asked them, "What are you discussing with them?" ~ Mark 9:16 (NASB 1995)

Every argument <u>about</u> Jesus is resolved only <u>in the presence</u> of Jesus.

And one of the crowd answered Him, "Teacher, I <u>brought</u> You my son, possessed with <u>a spirit which makes him mute</u>." ~ Mark 9:17 (NASB 1995)

ECHONTA PNEUMA ALALON - GREEK ~ literally, "having a mute spirit"

**ENENKA - GREEK** ~ to carry, to bring, to bear

and whenever it <u>seizes</u> him, it <u>slams</u> him to the ground and he foams at the mouth, and grinds his teeth and becomes stiff. <u>I told</u> Your disciples to cast it out, and they <u>could not do it</u>. ~ Mark 9:18 (NASB 1995)

**KATALAMBANO - GREEK** ~ to seize, to overtake, to grasp forcibly

RESSO - GREEK ~ to slam, to shatter, to dash down with force

EIPON - GREEK ~ "I said" or "I asked"

#### **EDYNETHESAN - GREEK** ~ were not able

The same Son who shines on the mountain still stoops into the dust to wrestle darkness for the sake of one broken child.

And He answered them and said, "O unbelieving generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I put up with you?..." ~ Mark 9:19a (NASB 1995)

# O GENEA APISTOS - GREEK ~ literally, "O generation without faith"

O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the city that kills the prophets and stones those sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, just as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, and you would not have it!

~ Luke 13:34 (NASB 1995)

**Bring him** to Me. ~ Mark 9:19b (NASB 1995)

## **PHERETE - GREEK** ~ carry him, bring him, bear him here
