AGANAKTEIN - GREEK ~ to be deeply indignant, displeased, irritated, provoked, stirred with anger

PROSKALESAMENOS - GREEK ~ called them to Himself, summoned, called near

OIDATE - GREEK ~ You know

KATAKYRIEVOUSIN - GREEK ~ lord it over them

KATEXOUSIAZOUSIN - GREEK ~ exercise authority over them, wield power over them

DIAKONOS - GREEK ~ a servant, a table-waiter, one who attends to needs, one who runs errands for the good of others

LYTRON - GREEK ~ a ransom, the price paid to release a slave, to free a captive, to redeem someone who cannot free themselves

JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 39

They were on the road going up to Jerusalem, and Jesus was walking on ahead of them; and they were amazed, and those who followed were fearful... ~ Mark 10:32a (NASB 1995)

PROAGON - GREEK ~ walking ahead of them, going before, leading the way as a guide or teacher

...And again He took the twelve aside and began to tell them what was going to happen to Him, ~ Mark 10:32b (NASB 1995)

PARALABON - GREEK ~ privately, off to the side

ERXATO AUTOIS LEGEIN - GREEK ~ began to tell to them

saying, "Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be delivered to the chief priests and the scribes; and they will condemn Him to death and will hand Him over to the Gentiles. ~ Mark 10:33 (NASB 1995)

IDOU - GREEK ~ behold, look, pay attention, lock in on this

PARADOTHESETAI - GREEK ~ delivered, or handed over, into the power of another

KATAKRINOUSIN AUTON THANATO - GREEK ~ they will judge against Him, pronounce a guilty verdict, condemning Him to death

They will mock Him and spit on Him, and scourge Him and kill Him, and three days later He will rise again." ~ Mark 10:34 (NASB 1995)

EMPAIXOUSIN - GREEK ~ mock, ridicule, to make sport of, to humiliate publicly

EMPTUSOUSIN - GREEK ~ to spit upon

MASTIGOSOUSIN - GREEK ~ whip, scourge

APOKTENOUSIN - GREEK ~ they will kill (Him)

ANASTESETAI - GREEK ~ will rise, will be raised

James and John, the two sons of Zebedee, came up to Jesus, saying, "Teacher, we want You to do for us whatever we ask of You." ~ Mark 10:35 (NASB 1995)

DIDASKALE - GREEK ~ Teacher

It's also possible for us to walk closely with Jesus and still be chasing the wrong version of His kingdom.

And He said to them, "What do you want Me to do for you?" ~ Mark 10:36 (NASB 1995)

They said to Him, "Grant that we may sit, one on Your right and one on Your left, in Your glory." ~ Mark 10:37 (NASB 1995)

DOS - GREEK ~ grant

KATHISOMEN - GREEK ~ that we may sit

It is possible to believe all the right things about Jesus and still pursue the wrong things for ourselves.

But Jesus said to them, "You do not know what you are asking. Are you able to drink the cup that I drink, or to be baptized with the baptism with which I am baptized?" ~ Mark 10:38 (NASB 1995)

DYNASTHE - GREEK ~ "are you able"

They said to Him, "We are able." ~ Mark 10:39a (NASB 1995)

DYNAMETHA - GREEK ~ "we are able"

And Jesus said to them, "The cup that I drink you shall drink; and you shall be baptized with the baptism with which I am baptized." ~ Mark 10:39b (NASB 1995)

Following Jesus will cost more than we realize, but God will meet us in that cost.

But to sit on My right or on My left, this is not Mine to give; but it is for those for whom it has been prepared." ~ Mark 10:40 (NASB 1995)
