## ❖ MESSAGE NOTES

### **JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 38**

And Jesus, *looking around*, said to His disciples, "How hard it will be for those who are wealthy to enter the kingdom of God!" ~ Mark 10:23 (NASB 1995)

**PERIBLEPSAMENOS - GREEK** ~ to look around deliberately, carefully, to take in everyone present

**The issue isn't that God resists the wealthy,  
but that wealth often resists God.**

The disciples were *amazed* at His words. But Jesus answered again and said to them, "Children, how hard it is to enter the kingdom of God!"  
~ Mark 10:24 (NASB 1995)

**ETHAMBOUNTO - GREEK from THAMBEO** ~ to be amazed, startled, shaken, or deeply unsettled, not just mildly surprised

**Don't confuse prosperity with proximity to God.**

**The difficulty in entering the kingdom is that the kingdom  
can only be received, not achieved.**

It is easier for a camel to go through the *eye* of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God. ~ Mark 10:25 (NASB 1995)

**TREMATOS RHAPHIDOS - GREEK** ~ "hole of the needle" - the literal eye (opening) of a sewing needle where you put the thread

*For the love of money is a root of all sorts of evil, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.* ~ 1 Timothy 6:10 (NASB 1995)

They were even *more astonished* and said to Him, "Then who can be saved?" ~ Mark 10:26 (NASB 1995)

**PERISSOS EXEPLESSONTO - GREEK** ~ exceedingly amazed, overwhelmed, stunned beyond measure

*Looking at them, Jesus said, "With people it is impossible, but not with God; for all things are possible with God."* ~ Mark 10:27 (NASB 1995)

**EMBLEPSAS - GREEK** ~ to look intently, to fix your gaze, to look deeply

**ADYNATON - GREEK** ~ impossible, powerless, unable, not doable

**With people it is impossible, but not with God;  
for all things are possible with God.**

**Salvation is never achieved; it is only received when given by God.**

Peter *began* to say to Him, "*Behold*, we have *left* everything and followed You." ~ (Mark 10:28 (NASB 1995)

**ARCHOMENOS - GREEK** ~ beginning, starting to do something; initiating an action or speech

**IDOU - GREEK** ~ behold, look, see, pay attention

**APHEKAMEN - GREEK** ~ left, released, let go of, sent away

Jesus said, "*Truly I say to you*, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or farms, for My sake and for the gospel's sake, but that he will receive a hundred times as much now in the present age, houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and farms, along with persecutions; and in the age to come, eternal life."  
~ Mark 10:30 (NASB 1995)

**AMEN LEGO HYMIN - GREEK** ~ truly I say to you

*But many who are first will be last, and the last, first."* ~ Mark 10:31 (NASB 1995)
