TI OUN POIESEI HO KYRIOS TOU AMPELONOS? - GREEK ~ What then will the lord of the vineyard do?

...He will come and destroy the vine-growers, and will give the vineyard to others. ~ Mark 12:9b (NASB 1995)

APOLESEI - GREEK ~ destroy, bring to ruin, put an end to the vine-growers

DOSEI TON AMPELONA ALLOIS - GREEK ~ he will give the vineyard to others

Have you not even read this Scripture: "The stone which the builders rejected, This became the chief corner stone; This came about from the Lord, And it is marvelous in our eyes?" ~ Mark 12:10-11 (NASB 1995)

NIFLA'AT - HEBREW ~ marvelous, extraordinary, astonishing, something so surprising it can only be explained as the work of God

*And they were seeking to seize Him, and yet they feared the people, for they understood that He spoke the parable against them...
~ Mark 12:12a (NASB 1995)*

EZETOUN AUTON KRATESAI - GREEK ~ they were trying to seize Him OR they were looking for a way to arrest Him

EGNOSAN GAR HOTI PROS AUTOUS TEN PARABOLEN EIPEN - GREEK ~ for they knew that He spoke the parable against them

EPHOBETHESAN - GREEK ~ feared

...And so they left Him and went away. ~ Mark 12:12b (NASB 1995)

❖ MESSAGE NOTES

JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 45

And He began to speak to them in parables: "A man planted a vineyard and put a wall around it, and dug a vat under the wine press and built a tower, and rented it out to vine-growers and went on a journey. ~ Mark 12:1 (NASB 1995)

AMPELONA ANTHROPOS EPHYTEUSEN - GREEK ~ a vineyard a man planted

PERIETHEKEN PHRAGMON - GREEK ~ placed a wall, a fence, a hedge, or a protective barrier

HYPOLENION - GREEK ~ "the place under the wine press"

PYRGON - GREEK ~ a watchtower or lookout structure

APEDEMESEN - GREEK ~ went on a journey, to travel abroad, to be away for an extended time

At the harvest time he sent a slave to the vine-growers, in order to receive some of the produce of the vineyard from the vine-growers. ~ Mark 12:2 (NASB 1995)

DOULON - GREEK ~ servant or slave, someone who acts with the authority of the one who sent him

TO KAIRO - GREEK ~ at the harvest time, at the appointed time

LABEIN APO TON KARPON - GREEK ~ to receive from the fruits

They took him, and beat him and sent him away empty-handed. ~ Mark 12:3 (NASB 1995)

LABONTES AUTON - GREEK ~ forcefully seized him

EDEIRAN AUTON - GREEK ~ beat him, struck him, flogged him

APESTEILAN KENON - GREEK ~ sent him away empty, without anything, without any result

Again he sent them another slave, and they wounded him in the head, and treated him shamefully. ~ Mark 12:4 (NASB 1995)

EKEPHALAIOSAN - GREEK ~ "to strike on the head"

ETIMASAN - GREEK ~ treated him shamefully

And he sent another, and that one they killed; and so with many others, beating some and killing others. ~ Mark 12:5 (NASB 1995)

APEKTEINAN AUTON - GREEK ~ they killed him or they put him to death

POLLOUS ALLOUS - GREEK ~ many others

He had one more to send, a beloved son; he sent him last of all to them, saying, "They will respect my son." ~ Mark 12:6 (NASB 1995)

ETI HENA EICHEN HUION AGAPETON - GREEK ~ he still had one, a beloved son

APESTEILEN AUTON ESCHATON - GREEK ~ he sent him last of all

ENTRAPESONTAI TON HUION MOU - GREEK ~ they will respect my son, OR they will feel shame before him, OR they will be moved to reverence, OR they will show honor and reverence to him

But those vine-growers said to one another, "This is the heir; come, let us kill him, and the inheritance will be ours!" ~ Mark 12:7 (NASB 1995)

PROS HEAUTOUS EIPAN - GREEK ~ they said among themselves

KLERONOMOS - GREEK ~ the inheritor, the one who has the legal right to receive the estate of the father

DEUTE APEKTEINOMEN AUTON - GREEK ~ Come, let us kill him

HEMON ESTAI HE KLERONOMIA - GREEK ~ the inheritance OR the property passed down to an heir will be ours

They took him, and killed him and threw him out of the vineyard. ~ Mark 12:8 (NASB 1995)

LABONTES AUTON - GREEK ~ seized, laid hold of, took control of him

APEKTEINAN AUTON - GREEK ~ killed him or put him to death

EXEBALON AUTON EXO TOU AMPELONOS - GREEK ~ they threw him outside the vineyard
