JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 46

Then they sent some of the Pharisees and Herodians to Him in order to trap Him in a statement. ~ Mark 12:13 (NASB 1995)

APOSTELLOUSIN - GREEK ~ they send, they dispatch, they commission

AUTON AGREUSOSIN - GREEK ~ catch Him, hunt Him, capture Him in a trap

LOGO - GREEK ~ in a word, in discourse, in a statement, in something He says publicly

They came and said to Him, "Teacher, we know that You are truthful and defer to no one; for You are not partial to any, but teach the way of God in truth. Is it lawful to pay a poll-tax to Caesar, or not? Shall we pay or shall we not pay?" ~ Mark 12:14-15a

DIDASKALE - GREEK ~ teacher

OU GAR BLEPEIS EIS PROSOPON ANTHROPON - GREEK ~ you do not look at the face of men

But He, knowing their hypocrisy, said to them, "Why are you testing Me? Bring Me a denarius to look at." They brought one. And He said to them, "Whose likeness and inscription is this?" And they said to Him, "Caesar's." ~ Mark 12:15b-16 (NASB 1995)

HYPOKRISIN - GREEK ~ hypocrisy, pretense, acting behind a mask

PEIRAZETE - GREEK ~ testing, tempting, trapping

And Jesus said to them, "Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's." And they were amazed at Him. ~ Mark 12:17 (NASB 1995)

APODOTE - GREEK ~ render, give back, repay, return what is owed

EXETHAUMAZON - GREEK ~ they were astonished, they marveled, they were left in wonder

Some Sadducees (who say that there is no resurrection) came to Jesus, and began questioning Him, saying, ~ Mark 12:18 (NASB 1995)

ANASTASIN - GREEK ~ resurrection

EPEROTON AUTON - GREEK ~ they began questioning Him, they began interrogating Him

Teacher, Moses wrote for us that if a man's brother dies and leaves behind a wife and leaves no child, his brother should marry the wife and raise up children to his brother. ~ Mark 12:19 (NASB 1995)

EXANASTESE SPERMA TO ADELPHO AUTOU - GREEK ~ to raise up seed for the brother of him

There were seven brothers; and the first took a wife, and died leaving no children. The second one married her, and died leaving behind no children; and the third likewise; and so all seven left no children. Last of all the woman died also. ~ Mark 12:20-22 (NASB 1995)

ESCHATON PANTON - GREEK ~ last of all

In the resurrection, when they rise again, which one's wife will she be? For all seven had married her." ~ Mark 12:23 (NASB 1995)

Jesus said to them, "Is this not the reason you are mistaken, that you do not understand the Scriptures or the power of God?" ~ Mark 12:24 (NASB 1995)

PLANASTHE - GREEK ~ do you mistake, do you wander, do you go astray, do you err

EIDOTES - GREEK ~ knowing, means to truly understand, to perceive, to fully grasp what it means

DYNAMIN - GREEK ~ power, ability, mighty capability. It's where we get the word dynamite from
