When God Shakes Everything

READ: Mark 13:24–25; Isaiah 13:10

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1) What stands out to you about the shift from earthly events to cosmic imagery in this passage?
- 2) Why do you think Scripture repeatedly describes God's intervention as creation "shaking" or "darkening"?
- 3) Pastor G said, "This isn't just a tremor... it's a celestial eviction." What do you think he meant by that?
- 4) What in your life feels "stable" right now—and how does this passage challenge where your true stability should be?

The Moment No One Can Miss

READ: Mark 13:26; Revelation 1:7

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1) According to these verses, how will Jesus' return be different from false claims about the Messiah?
- 2) Why is it important that Jesus says "they will see"—not "they will hear about it"?
- 3) Pastor G said, "When it's real, you won't need to be told." How does that help you discern truth in a world full of deception?
- 4) How should the certainty and visibility of Christ's return shape the way you live today?

Gathered, Not Scattered

READ: Mark 13:27; 1 Thessalonians 4:16–17

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1) What does it mean to you that Jesus will personally gather His people from "the four winds"?
- 2) How does this passage redefine what it means to be "the elect"?
- 3) Pastor G said, "The category of the elect is fixed, but the invitation is open." What does that mean for you personally?
- 4) How does the promise that "not one will be missed" bring comfort—or challenge—to your faith?

Recognizing the Season

READ: Mark 13:28–29; 1 Thessalonians 5:4–6

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1) What does the fig tree parable teach about recognizing spiritual seasons?
- 2) What's the difference between being alert and being anxious about the end times?
- 3) Pastor G said, "Awareness without panic. Discernment without date-setting." Where do you tend to lean—panic or indifference?
- 4) What is one practical way you can stay spiritually awake and ready this week?
