## ❖ MESSAGE NOTES

### **JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 48**

In His teaching He was saying: "Beware of the scribes who like to walk around in long robes, and like respectful greetings in the market places," ~ Mark 12:38 (NASB 1995)

**BLEPETE - GREEK** ~ beware, watch out, pay attention, be on guard

**STOLAIS - GREEK** ~ long flowing robes or ceremonial garments

**ASPASMOUS - GREEK** ~ greetings

**AGORAIS - GREEK** ~ the public square where daily life unfolded, marketplaces

*and chief seats in the synagogues and places of honor at banquets,*  
~ Mark 12:39 (NASB 1995)

**PROTOKATHEDRIAS - GREEK** ~ literally the first seats

**PROTOKLISIAS - GREEK** ~ the first reclining places

*who devour widows' houses, ...* ~ Mark 12:40a (NASB 1995)

**KATESTHIOUSIN - GREEK** ~ to devour, consume, eat up completely

*You shall not afflict any widow or orphan.* ~ Exodus 22:22 (NASB 1995)

*...Defend the orphan, Plead for the widow.* ~ Isaiah 1:17b (NASB 1995)

*...and for appearance's sake offer long prayers; these will receive greater condemnation.* ~ Mark 12:40b (NASB 1995)

**PROPHASEI - GREEK** ~ for a pretense, for a show, under the appearance of something

**PERISSOTERON KRIMA - GREEK** ~ a greater or more severe judgment

*Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap.* ~ Galatians 6:7 (NASB 1995)

*Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe to stumble, it would be better for him if, with a heavy millstone hung around his neck, he had been cast into the sea.* ~ Mark 9:42 (NASB 1995)

*And He sat down opposite the treasury, and began observing how the people were putting money into the treasury; and many rich people were putting in large sums.* ~ Mark 12:41 (NASB 1995)

**GAZOPHYLAKIOU - GREEK** ~ treasury

**ETHEOREI - GREEK** ~ watching carefully, observing closely, studying attentively

**POLLA - GREEK** ~ much, abundant

*A poor widow came and put in two small copper coins, which amount to a cent.* ~ Mark 12:42 (NASB 1995)

**CHERA PTOCHE - GREEK** ~ a poor widow, a destitute widow

**LEPTA - GREEK** ~ very small copper coins, the smallest Jewish coins in circulation

**KODRANTES - GREEK** ~ a Roman coin of extremely small value

*Calling His disciples to Him, He said to them, "Truly I say to you, this poor widow put in more than all the contributors to the treasury;"*  
~ Mark 12:43 (NASB 1995)

**AMEN LEGO HYMIN - GREEK** ~ truly I tell you

**It's not about the number of coins in the gift.  
It's about what the gift represents in the life of the giver.**

*for they all put in out of their surplus, but she, out of her poverty, put in all she owned, all she had to live on."* ~ Mark 12:44 (NASB 1995)
