JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 55

Then Judas Iscariot, who was one of the twelve, went off to the chief priests in order to betray Him to them. ~ Mark 14:10 (NASB 1995)

... “Did I Myself not choose you, the twelve, and yet one of you is a devil?” Now He meant Judas the son of Simon Iscariot, for he, one of the twelve, was going to betray Him.” ~ John 6:70b-71 (NASB 1995)

PARADIDOMI - GREEK ~ to hand over, to deliver, to betray

For the love of money is a root of all sorts of evil, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs. ~ 1 Timothy 6:10 (NASB 1995)

For what does it profit a man to gain the whole world and forfeit his soul?
~ Mark 8:36 (NASB 1995)

**Physical proximity to Jesus is not the same thing
as genuine devotion to Jesus!**

**It is possible to be close enough to Jesus to hear His voice
and still let your heart drift far from Him!**

ECHARESAN - GREEK ~ rejoiced, were delighted, were glad

EZETEI - GREEK ~ seeking

EUKAIROS - GREEK ~ a favorable time, a convenient time, a strategic moment

Now the Feast of Unleavened Bread, which is called the Passover, was approaching. ~ Luke 22:1 (NASB 1995)



On the first day of Unleavened Bread, when the Passover lamb was being sacrificed, His disciples said to Him, “Where do You want us to go and prepare for You to eat the Passover?” ~ Mark 14:12 (NASB 1995)

And He sent two of His disciples and said to them, “Go into the city, and a man will meet you carrying a pitcher of water; follow him; and wherever he enters, say to the owner of the house, ‘The Teacher says, “Where is My guest room in which I may eat the Passover with My disciples?’” And he himself will show you a large upper room furnished and ready; prepare for us there. The disciples went out and came to the city, and found it just as He had told them; and they prepared the Passover. ~ Mark 14:13-16 (NASB 1995)

Two are better than one because they have a good return for their labor. For if either of them falls, the one will lift up his companion. But woe to the one who falls when there is not another to lift him up. Furthermore, if two lie down together they keep warm, but how can one be warm alone? And if one can overpower him who is alone, two can resist him. A cord of three strands is not quickly torn apart. ~ Ecclesiastes 4:9-11, 12b (NASB 1995)

When it was evening He came with the twelve. As they were reclining at the table and eating, Jesus said, “Truly I say to you that one of you will betray Me—one who is eating with Me.” They began to be grieved and to say to Him one by one, “Surely not I?” ~ Mark 14:17-19 (NASB 1995)
