**JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 56**

*While they were eating, He took some bread, and after a blessing He broke it, and gave it to them, and said, "Take it; this is My body."  
~ Mark 14:22 (NASB 1995)*

**EULOGESAS - GREEK ~ having blessed**

**Salvation is a gift that must be personally received.  
Christ's sacrifice is sufficient for all,  
but it must be individually received.**

*And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave it to them,  
and they all drank from it. ~ Mark 14:23 (NASB 1995)*

**EUCCHARISTESAS - GREEK ~ having given thanks**

**Communion reminds us that the ground is level at the foot of the cross.  
Every believer comes to Jesus the same way, only by grace alone.**

*And He said to them, "This is My blood of the covenant,  
which is poured out for many. ~ Mark 14:24 (NASB 1995)*

**B'RIT CHADASHAH - HEBREW ~ new covenant**

*"Behold, days are coming," declares the Lord, "when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah ... I will put My law within them and on their heart I will write it; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people... for I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more." ~ Jeremiah 31:31, 33b, 34b (NASB 1995)*

**EKCHUNNOMENON - GREEK ~ being poured out, being spilled out**

*Truly I say to you, I will never again drink of the fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God." ~ Mark 14:25 (NASB 1995)*

**KAINOS - GREEK ~ new in quality, new in kind, fresh, not merely recent**
