JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 61

And Jesus said to them, "Have you come out with swords and clubs to arrest Me, as you would against a robber?" ~ Mark 14:48 (NASB)

LESTEN - GREEK ~ a robber, bandit, insurrectionist

"Every day I was with you in the temple teaching, and you did not seize Me"... ~ Mark 14:49a (NASB 1995)

..."but this has taken place to fulfill the Scriptures." ~ Mark 14:49b (NASB)

And they all left Him and fled. ~ Mark 14:50 (NASB)

A young man was following Him, wearing nothing but a linen sheet over his naked body; and they seized him. ~ Mark 14:51 (NASB)

NEANISKOS - GREEK ~ a young man

SINDONA - GREEK ~ a linen cloth OR a linen garment

*But he pulled free of the linen sheet and escaped naked.
~ Mark 14:52 (NASB 1995)*

They led Jesus away to the high priest; and all the chief priests and the elders and the scribes gathered together. ~ Mark 14:53 (NASB 1995)

APEGAGON - GREEK ~ they led away, they escorted, they took into custody
