❖ MESSAGE NOTES

JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 62

Peter had followed Him at a distance, right into the courtyard of the high priest; and he was sitting with the officers and warming himself at the fire.

~ Mark 14:54 (NASB 1995)

MAKROTHEN - GREEK ~ “from afar” or “at a distance”

*How blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked,
Nor stand in the path of sinners, Nor sit in the seat of scoffers!*

~ Psalm 1:1 (NASB 1995)

Now the chief priests and the whole Council kept trying to obtain testimony against Jesus to put Him to death, and they were not finding any.

~ Mark 14:55 (NASB 1995)

SYNEDRION - GREEK ~ Council, literally “those who sit together” or “a sitting together”

Knowing the Bible and knowing the God of the Bible are not necessarily the same thing. A person can possess tremendous biblical knowledge and still completely miss Jesus.

EZETOUN - GREEK ~ kept trying or kept seeking

... oppressed and ... afflicted ... Like a lamb that is led to slaughter ...

9b ... He had done no violence, Nor was there any deceit in His mouth.

~ Isaiah 53:7b, 9b (NASB 1995)

For many were giving false testimony against Him, but their testimony was not consistent. ~ Mark 14:56 (NASB 1995)

EPSEUDOMARTYROUN - GREEK ~ were bearing false witness or giving false testimony

You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor

~ Exodus 20:16 (NASB 1995)

ISAI - GREEK ~ equal, matching, agreeing, consistent

On the evidence of two witnesses or three witnesses, he who is to die shall be put to death; he shall not be put to death on the evidence of one witness.

~ Deuteronomy 17:6 (NASB 1995)

A single witness shall not rise up against a man on account of any iniquity or any sin which he has committed; on the evidence of two or three witnesses a matter shall be confirmed. ~ Deuteronomy 19:15 (NASB 1995)

Some stood up and began to give false testimony against Him, saying, “We heard Him say, ‘I will destroy this temple made with hands, and in three days I will build another made without hands.’” ~ Mark 14:57-58 (NASB 1995)

After cleansing the Temple early in His ministry, Jesus declared, “Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.” ~ John 2:19 (NASB 1995)

He was speaking of the temple of His body. ~ John 2:21 (NASB 1995)

However, the Most High does not dwell in houses made by human hands; as the prophet says: “Heaven is My throne, And earth is the footstool of My feet; What kind of house will you build for Me?” says the Lord, Or what place is there for My repose?” ~ Acts 7:48-49 (NASB 1995)

... He entered through the greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this creation; ... For Christ did not enter a holy place made with hands, a mere copy of the true one, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us; ~ Hebrews 9:11, 24 (NASB 1995)

Religious people often have a tendency to cling more tightly to the symbols of our faith than to the Savior those symbols were designed to reveal.

Christianity is a relationship WITH Jesus.**
