JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 63

Have we become more devoted to Christianity than we are to Christ?

The high priest stood up and came forward and questioned Jesus, saying, "Do You not answer? What is it that these men are testifying against You?"
~ Mark 14:60 (NASB 1995)

ANASTAS EIS MESON - GREEK ~ stood up into the middle

But He kept silent and did not answer.... ~ Mark 14:61a (NASB 1995)

He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He did not open His mouth; Like a lamb that is led to slaughter, And like a sheep that is silent before its shearers, So He did not open His mouth." ~ Isaiah 53:7 (NASB 1995)

... Again the high priest was questioning Him, and saying to Him, "Are You the Christ, the Son of the Blessed One?" ~ Mark 14:61b (NASB 1995)

CHRISTOS - GREEK ~ Anointed One

MASHIACH - HEBREW ~ Anointed One, Messiah

And Jesus said, "I am;"... ~ Mark 14:62a (NASB 1995)

ANA - ARAMAIC ~ I am

EGO EIMI - GREEK ~ I am

EHYEH ASHER EHYEH - HEBREW ~ I AM WHO I AM

Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I AM."
~ John 8:58 (NASB 1995)

... and you shall see the Son of Man... ~ Mark 14:62b (NASB 1995)

I kept looking in the night visions, And behold, with the clouds of heaven One like a Son of Man was coming, And He came up to the Ancient of Days And was presented before Him. And to Him was given dominion, Glory and a kingdom, That all the peoples, nations and men of every language Might serve Him.

His dominion is an everlasting dominion Which will not pass away; And His kingdom is one Which will not be destroyed. ~ Daniel 7:13-14 (NASB 1995)

Never judge God's purposes by today's headlines or tomorrow's circumstances.

...sitting at the right hand of Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven.
~ Mark 14:62c (NASB 1995)

The Lord says to my Lord: 'Sit at My right hand until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet.'" ~ Psalm 110:1 (NASB 1995)

Tearing his clothes... ~ Mark 14:63a (NASB 1995)

**Religious sincerity is not the same thing as spiritual truth.
A person can be deeply convinced, morally outraged, and sincerely
believe they are defending God while actually opposing Him.**

... the high priest said, "What further need do we have of witnesses?"
~ Mark 14:63b (NASB 1995).

You have heard the blasphemy; how does it seem to you?" And they all condemned Him to be deserving of death. ~ Mark 14:64 (NASB 1995)

**KATEKRINAN AUTON - GREEK ~ condemned Him, pronounced Him
guilty, passed sentence against Him**

ENOCHON THANATOU - GREEK ~guilty of death, deserving of death

Some began to spit at Him, and to blindfold Him, and to beat Him with their fists, and to say to Him, "Prophecy!" ... ~ Mark 14:65a (NASB 1995)

KOLAPHIZEIN - GREEK ~ to strike with the fist, to punch

"I gave My back to those who strike Me, And My cheeks to those who pluck out the beard; I did not cover My face from humiliation and spitting."
~ Isaiah 50:6 (NASB 1995)

...And the officers received Him with slaps in the face.
~ Mark 14:65b (NASB 1995)

RHAPISMASIN - GREEK ~ with slaps, with open-handed blows
