❖ MESSAGE NOTES

JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 64

As Peter was below in the courtyard, one of the servant-girls of the high priest came, ~ Mark 14:66 (NASB 1995)

KATO EN TE AULE - GREEK ~ below in the courtyard

MIA TON PAIDISKON - GREEK ~ one of the servant-girls

and seeing Peter warming himself, she looked at him and said, "You also were with Jesus the Nazarene." ~ Mark 14:67 (NASB 1995)

But he denied it, saying, "I neither know nor understand what you are talking about." ... ~ Mark 14:68 a (NASB 1995)

ERNESATO - GREEK ~ he denied it or repudiated it

OUTE OIDA - GREEK ~ I neither know

OUTE EPISTAMAI - GREEK ~ nor do I understand

... And he went out onto the porch. ~ Mark 14:68b (NASB 1995)

PROAULION - GREEK ~ forecourt, entryway, or vestibule, the area leading from the main courtyard toward the entrance or gateway

The servant-girl saw him, and began once more to say to the bystanders, "This is one of them!" ~ Mark 14:69 (NASB 1995)

But again he denied it. ... ~ Mark 14:70a (NASB 1995)

PALIN ERNEITO - GREEK ~ again he was denying it

... And after a little while the bystanders were again saying to Peter, "Surely you are one of them, for you are a Galilean too." ~ Mark 14:70b ~ (NASB 1995)

But he began to curse and swear, "I do not know this man you are talking about!" ~ Mark 14:71 (NASB 1995)

ANATHEMATIZEIN - GREEK ~ to curse, to invoke a curse

OMNYNAI - GREEK ~ to swear an oath

Immediately a rooster crowed a second time. And Peter remembered how Jesus had made the remark to him, "Before a rooster crows twice, you will deny Me three times." ... ~ Mark 14:72a (NASB 1995)

EUTHYS - GREEK ~ immediately, at once

ANEMNESTHE - GREEK ~ remembered, recalled, brought back to mind

... And he began to weep. ~ Mark 72b (NASB 1995)

EPIBALON EKLAIEN - GREEK ~ breaking down, he began to weep

PIKROS - GREEK ~ bitterly, intensely, with profound grief
