❖ MESSAGE NOTES

JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 65

Early in the morning the chief priests with the elders and scribes and the whole Council, immediately held a consultation; and binding Jesus, they led Him away and delivered Him to Pilate. ~ Mark 15:1 (NASB 1995)

So Pilate said to them, “Take Him yourselves, and judge Him according to your law.” The Jews said to him, “We are not permitted to put anyone to death.” ~ John 18:31 (NASB 1995)

PAREDŌKAN - GREEK ~ they handed [Him] over

*Pilate questioned Him, “Are You the King of the Jews?”...
~ Mark 15:2a (NASB 1995)*

...And He answered him, “It is as you say.” ~ Mark 15:2b (NASB 1995)

SY LEGEIS - GREEK ~ literally, You say or You say [it]

EGŌ EIMI - GREEK ~ I AM

The chief priests began to accuse Him harshly. ~ Mark 15:3 (NASB 1995)

KATĒGOROUN - GREEK ~ they were accusing, they kept accusing

*You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
~ Exodus 20:16 (NASB 1995)*

Then Pilate questioned Him again, saying, “Do You not answer? See how many charges they bring against You!” ~ Mark 15:4 (NASB 1995)

EPĒRŌTA - GREEK ~ was questioning

PALIN - GREEK ~ again

But I, like a deaf man, do not hear; And I am like a mute man who does not open his mouth. Yes, I am like a man who does not hear, And in whose mouth are no arguments. ~ Psalm 38:13–14 (NASB 1995)

*But Jesus made no further answer; so Pilate was amazed.
~ Mark 15:5 (NASB 1995)*

THAUMAZEIN - GREEK ~ was amazed, marveled, wondered

Now at the feast he used to release for them any one prisoner whom they requested. ~ Mark 15:6 (NASB 1995)

APELYEN - GREEK ~ he used to release

HO OCHLOS - GREEK ~ the crowd
