❖ MESSAGE NOTES

JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 67

The soldiers took Him away into the palace (that is, the Praetorium), and they called together the whole Roman cohort. ~ Mark 15:16 (NASB 1995)

PRAITÓRION - GREEK ~ Praetorium

SPEÎRAN - GREEK ~ cohort

They dressed Him up in purple, and after twisting a crown of thorns, they put it on Him; ~ Mark 15:17 (NASB 1995)

PORPHÝRAN - GREEK ~ purple

STÉPHANON - GREEK ~ crown or wreath

Cursed is the ground because of you; In toil you will eat of it All the days of your life. "Both thorns and thistles it shall grow for you..." ~ Genesis 3:17b-18a (NASB 1995)

and they began to acclaim Him, "Hail, King of the Jews!" ~ Mark 15:18 (NASB 1995)

ÉRAXANTO ASPÁZESTHAI - GREEK ~ they began to greet or to salute

They kept beating His head with a reed, and spitting on Him, and kneeling and bowing before Him. ~ Mark 15:19 (NASB 1995)

ÉTYPTON AUTOÛ TÈN KEPHALÈN - GREEK ~ they kept beating His head

PROSEKÝNOUN - GREEK ~ bowing down or prostrating themselves

We too can bow on the OUTSIDE without ever bowing on the INSIDE.

... at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and ... every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. ~ Philippians 2:10b-11 (NASB 1995)

After they had mocked Him, they took the purple robe off Him and put His own garments on Him. And they led Him out to crucify Him. ~ Mark 15:20 (NASB 1995)

PATIBULUM - LATIN ~ the horizontal crossbeam of His cross

They pressed into service a passer-by coming from the country, Simon of Cyrene (the father of Alexander and Rufus), to bear His cross. ~ Mark 15:21b (NASB 1995)

ANGAREUOÚSIN - GREEK ~ they press into service

... "If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross and follow Me." ~ Mark 8:34 (NASB 1995)

Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap. ~ Galatians 6:7 (NASB 1995)
