JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 68

Then they brought Him to the place Golgotha, which is translated,
Place of a Skull. ~ Mark 15:22 (NASB 1995)

GOLGOTHÂN - GREEK ~ Golgotha

GULGULTA - ARAMAIC ~ skull

CALVARIA - LATIN ~ skull, Calvary

They tried to give Him wine mixed with myrrh; but He did not take it.
~ Mark 15:23 (NASB 1995)

ESMYRNISMÉNON OÎNON - GREEK ~ wine mixed with myrrh

OÎNON METÀ CHOLÊS MEMIGMÉNON - GREEK ~ wine mixed with gall,
with something bitter (*Matthew's Account*)

They also gave me gall for my food, And for my thirst they gave me
vinegar to drink. ~ Psalm 69:21 (NASB 1995)

And they crucified Him ... ~ Mark 15:24a (NASB 1995)

... A band of evildoers has encompassed me; They pierced my hands and
my feet. I can count all my bones. They look, they stare at me;
~ Psalm 22:16b-17 (NASB 1995)

My God, my God, why have You forsaken me? ~ Psalm 22:1a (NASB 1995)

... and divided up His garments among themselves, casting lots for them to
decide what each man should take. ~ Mark 15:24b (NASB 1995)

They divide my garments among them, And for my clothing they cast lots.
~ Psalm 22:18 (NASB 1995)

It was the third hour when they crucified Him. ~ Mark 15:25 (NASB 1995)

but He, having offered one sacrifice for sins for all time, SAT DOWN AT THE
RIGHT HAND OF GOD. ~ Hebrews 10:12 (NASB 1995)

The inscription of the charge against Him read, "THE KING OF THE JEWS."
~ Mark 15:26 (NASB 1995)

They crucified two robbers with Him, one on His right and one on His left.
~ Mark 15:27 (NASB 1995)

LĒISTÁS - GREEK ~ robbers, bandits, violent outlaws, or
revolutionaries

And Jesus said to them, "Have you come out with swords and clubs
to arrest Me, as you would against a robber?" ~ Mark 14:48

LĒISTĒN - GREEK ~ a robber

... Because He poured out Himself to death, And was numbered with the
transgressors; Yet He Himself bore the sin of many, And interceded for the
transgressors. ~ Isaiah 53:12b (NASB 1995)

And the Scripture was fulfilled which says, "And He was numbered with
transgressors." ~ Mark 15:28 (NASB 1995)

"For I tell you that this which is written must be fulfilled in Me, 'And He was
numbered with transgressors'; for that which refers to Me has its fulfillment."
~ Luke 22:37 (NASB 1995)
