ABUSSOS - GREEK ~ bottomless pit

The Perplexing Possessed Pig Plunge Paradox

Now there was a large herd of swine feeding nearby on the mountain. ~ Mark 5:11 (NASB 1995)

The demons implored Him, saying, "Send us into the swine so that we may enter them." ~ Mark 5:12 (NASB 1995)

Now when the unclean spirit goes out of a man, it passes through waterless places seeking rest, and does not find it. Then it says, "I will return to my house from which I came"; and when it comes, it finds it unoccupied, swept, and put in order. Then it goes and takes along with it seven other spirits more wicked than itself, and they go in and live there; and the last state of that man becomes worse than the first. ... ~ Matthew 12:43-45a (NASB 1995)

<u>Their herdsmen ran away</u> and <u>reported</u> it in the city and in the country. And the people came to see what it was that had happened. ~ Mark 5:14 (NASB 1995)

HOI DE BOSKONTES - GREEK ~ Now the ones feeding [them]

EPHYGON - GREEK ~ they ran away in fear or urgency, they fled

APENGEILAN - GREEK ~ reported, told

They came to Jesus and <u>saw</u> the man who had been demon-possessed sitting down, clothed and <u>in his right mind</u>, the very man who had had the 'Legion'; and <u>they became frightened</u>. ~ Mark 5:15 (NASB 1995)

THEOROUSIN - GREEK ~ to observe carefully

SOPHRONOUNTA - GREEK ~ in his right mind

KAI EPHOBETHESAN - GREEK ~ and they were afraid

TWO POSSIBLE REASONS FOR THEIR FEAR

FEAR #1: "What Else Might His Judgment Take Away?"
FEAR #2: "Is Someone Who Casts Out Demons Worse Than the Demons?"

Those who had seen it described to them how it had happened to the demonpossessed man, and all about the swine. ~ MARK 5:16 (NASB 1995)

And they began <u>to implore</u> Him <u>to leave</u> <u>their region</u>. ~ MARK 5:17 (NASB 1995)

PARALALEIN - GREEK ~ to beg, plead, implore

APELTHEIN - GREEK ~ to go away, to depart, be gone

APO TON HORION - GREEK ~ from their region or boundaries

As He was getting into the boat, the man who had been demon-possessed was imploring Him that he might accompany Him. ~ Mark 5:18 (NASB 1995)

HINA MET' AUTOU E - GREEK ~ that he might be with Him

And He did not let him, but He said to him, "Go home to your people and report to them what great things the Lord has done for you, and how He had mercy on you." ~ Mark 5:19 (NASB 1995)
