### JUST JESUS: A Journey Through Mark ~ Part 54

*Now the Passover and Unleavened Bread were two days away; and the chief priests and the scribes were seeking how to seize Him by stealth and kill Him; ~ Mark 14:1 (NASB 1995)*

**EZETOUN - GREEK ~ seeking**

**EN DOLO KRATESANTES - GREEK ~ seize by stealth**

**APOKTEINOSIN - GREEK ~ kill**

**You can be deeply religious, highly respected, theologically trained, and still completely miss Jesus! Because knowing things about God is not the same as recognizing and following His Son.**

*for they were saying, "Not during the festival, otherwise there might be a riot of the people." ~ Mark 14:2 (NASB 1995)*

**ELEGON GAR - GREEK ~ for they were saying**

**THORYBOS - GREEK ~ riot**

*While He was in Bethany at the home of Simon the leper, and reclining at the table, there came a woman with an alabaster vial of very costly perfume of pure nard; and she broke the vial and poured it over His head.  
~ Mark 14:3 (NASB 1995)*

**SIMONOS TOU LEPROU - GREEK ~ Simon the Leper**

**KATAKEIMENOU - GREEK ~ reclining, lying back**

**ALABASTRON - GREEK ~ a sealed alabaster flask**

**MYROU - GREEK ~ costly, perfumed oil**

**NARDOU - GREEK ~ spikenard imported from India**

**PISTIKES - GREEK ~ genuine, pure, authentic, unadulterated**

**POLYTELOUS - GREEK ~ exceedingly valuable, precious, and costly**

**SUNTRIPSASA - GREEK ~ broke**

**KATECHEEN - GREEK ~ poured out, lavished**

**You can sit right in the room with Jesus, and still miss Him.**

*But some were indignantly remarking to one another, "Why has this perfume been wasted?" ~ Mark 14:4 (NASB 1995)*

**AGANAKTOUNTES - GREEK ~ moved with indignation; deeply pained; bordering on rage**

**PROS HEAUTOYS - GREEK ~ among themselves**

**APOLEIA - GREEK ~ wasted, ruined**

*For this perfume might have been sold for over three hundred denarii, and the money given to the poor." And they were scolding her.  
~ Mark 14:5 (NASB 1995)*

**ENEBRIMONTO - GREEK ~ to roar at, to storm at, to rebuke harshly, to scold**

**DENARION - GREEK ~ a silver Roman coin, typically representing one day's wages for a common laborer**

*Now he said this, not because he was concerned about the poor, but because he was a thief, and as he had the money box, he used to pilfer what was put into it. ~ John 12:6 (NASB 1995)*

*But Jesus said, "Let her alone; why do you bother her? She has done a good deed to Me." ~ Mark 14:6 (NASB 1995)*

**APHETE AUTEN - GREEK ~ Let her alone! Leave her be!**

**KOPOUS - GREEK ~ bother, trouble, cause grief**
